## "What's a Dummy Jump?"

- \* Get together a group of like-minded individuals and build a dummy (a fake human or icon) and we'll send it off a jump and let it CRASH!
- \* Judges will score on creativity, amplitude, & the biggest crash
- \* Your dummy must be appropriate (this is a family event).
- \* Must be able to slide unassisted, & cannot have a human or living thing attached.
- \* Every person that enters will receive a \$15 lift ticket .

A portion of the proceeds will go to the March of Dimes Organization.

Leave no trace: only weight your dummy with things that can be easily cleaned up. No concrete, sand or dirt which will mark the slopes and may damage snowboards or skis (hint: water works well when frozen). Remember there are children watching so keep it reasonably clean. Your dummy should also be a recognizable form of something. So put on your creative dummy building hats, roll up your sleeves, get down and snowy and of course...come join the fun!!

It's time for the 3rd Annual Buena Vista Dummy Jump. "What's a dummy jump?" you ask: well, you and a like minded group of individuals, assemble a fake human or icon from whatever parts you choose, secure it to a pair of skis and launch it down the ski hill for a big air jump and crash. Buena Vista Ski Area invites businesses, organizations or individuals to create their own Dummy and join in the fun. Buena Vista can even provide free skis for your dummy. **Fine print:** Leave no trace: only weight your dummy with things that can be easily cleaned up. No concrete, sand or dirt which will mark the slopes and may damage snowboards or skis. Water freezes well and is heavy so works well. Remember, there will be children watching so keep it reasonably clean and your dummy should be a recognizable form of something.

**Hints:** Balance, balance, balance – use two skis (no single skis, snowboards, etc.). Weight helps but we have to be able to get it up the hill with a snowmobile and it has to safely land in a drop zone so don't make it too heavy. Dummy scoring is based on height of jump and destruction upon impact. No explosives or pyrotechnics.

**Judging:** Scores are based on creativity, height of jump, destruction upon impact and audience applause (so bring your loud friends to watch).

**Prizes: Top 3 Dummies will be awarded cash prizes and the 1<sup>st</sup> place winner will be given the Traveling Trophy.**
