

COVID-19 INFORMATION

Buena Vista Ski Area is working with the Minnesota Ski Area Association to safely operate for the 2020-2021 season. We appreciate your cooperation as we all adjust to this new normal.

Stay Home if sick: If you are experiencing symptoms of Covid-19. Please stay home or go home. Buena Vista will be perform daily wellness checks of all employees prior to the start of their shift.

Face Coverings: Guests and employees must wear Face Coverings when indoors and outdoors. Face Coverings are required in lift lines, while loading, riding on the chairlift and unloading, tubing lines, tubing loading and unloading, rental lines, food lines.

Chalet: Indoor seating is now open at 50% capacity. Tables may not be reserved. Bags and items must not be left on tables. Please use the cubbies. Please be courteous so others may use tables. Bathrooms, tickets, rental shop, food service and retail continue to be open.

Boot up in Car: Please boot up/get ready in your vehicle. Please leave your belongings in your car. We will not be allowing any ski bags/backpacks on the tables or in the chalet. Day and season lockers are available for rent.

Riding the Lifts: Chairs are limited to members of the same household.

Physical Distancing: Guests are required to follow physical distancing of 6 feet whenever possible. This includes lift lines, front desk lines, rental lines and food lines.

Continental Cafe: Ski areas are allowed to operate at 50% capacity. Guests must be seated at a table to consume food and beverages. Our outdoor fireplace and fire ring are also available for food consumption.

Ski/Board Lessons: Online Reservations are required and must be confirmed by ski school director. Instructor and guests will be required to wear face coverings. Lessons are limited to a single instructor and single household.

Cleaning & Disinfecting: We will conduct routine cleaning and disinfecting high touch areas. Sanitation stations will be available for guests.

Ski Patrol Operations: Buena Vista Ski Patrol will follow all recommendations established by Buena Vista, Federal and local health authorities, and the National Ski Patrol. Buena Vista Patrollers will ensure they have all the necessary PPE and will engage in patient care wearing all proper PPE.
